## Bible Facts

- 1. The word "bible" is from the Greek word biblia which means scrolls. The word is derived from the ancient city Byblos which was the official supplier of paper products in the ancient world.
- 2. In 1631 a publishing company published a Bible with the "typo" Thou shalt commit adultery". Only nine of the these Bibles known as the "Sinners' Bible" exist today.
- 3. The longest word in the Bible is Maher-Shalal-Hash-Baz. Isaiah 8:3.
- 4. It took over a 1,000 years to write the Old testament, the New Testament was written within 50-75 years.
- 5. The longest book in the Bible is Psalm 119 with 176 verses and the shortest is Psalm 117 with 2 verses.
