Three Questions:

1.	Are you ready to put God between you and your
	circumstances by allowing the Holy Spirit to change you
	forever?

2. Can you embrace a level of faith that will enable to you to believe for that which you thought was impossible?

3. Are you willing to embrace the fear of God and receive freedom from every other fear that has held you hostage?

We must embrace the things that are on God's heart when we pray

- 1. Those who have no faith
- 2. Those who have fallen away
- 3. Unity in the churches
- 4. Respect for all life
- 5. For all the lost, abandoned and forgotten children
- 6. For those who are under the power of addiction those bound by depression, anxiety or bitterness
- 7. For those held prisoner for proclaiming the name of Jesus

We can start our intercession by letting go of the things that will keep us from praying

- Repent of everything that you know of that would prevent God from hearing your prayer
- Receive God's forgiveness for everything you have done that you know was against His will
- Believe that you never have to live another day of your life without the peace of knowing He is in control
- Accept the things you cannot change believing that God will ultimately work it out for your good because you choose to love Him
- 5. Embrace the call of God on your life and rejoice that you now have purpose that will fill your destiny
