Defining Moments of the Holy Spirit 10 Reasons Why the Holy Spirit Says I Am Holy

¹¹ Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord. **Romans 6:11**

In order for us to operate in the power of the Holy Spirt we must believe that we are holy as we live our lives in obedience to His word.

I am Holy if I:

1. Walk in the Spirit and do not fulfil the lust of the flesh

¹⁶ I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. **Galatians 5:16**

2. I believe I have been crucified with Christ ... and Christ lives in me... and I live by faith in the Son of God

²⁰ I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. **Galatians 2:20**

3. Though I walk in the flesh .. the weapons of my warfare are mighty in God for the pulling down of strongholds

³ For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. ⁴ For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, **2 Corinthians 10:3-4**

4. I will no longer live in deception. What I sow I will reap. I choose to sow to the Spirit and reap everlasting life

⁷ Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. ⁸ For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life. **Galatians 6:7-8**

5. I belong to Christ and have crucified the flesh

²⁴ And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. **Galatians 5:24-25**

6. I present my body daily to the Lord as a living sacrifice through my willing service to Him

¹ I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. ² And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. **Romans 12:1-2**

7. I will put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provisions for the flesh to fulfill its lust

¹⁴ But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts. **Romans 13:14**

8. I have set my mind on the Spirit where there is life and peace because the Spirit dwells in me

⁵ For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. ⁶ For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. ⁷ Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. ⁸ So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. **Romans 8:5-8**

9. I will not present the members of my body as instruments of unrighteousness but of righteousness unto God.

¹² Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. ¹³ And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God. **Romans 6:12-13**

10. As he who called me is holy, I also will be holy in all of my conduct

¹⁵ but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, **I Peter 1:15**
