Day 3: “Jesus In the Garden”



Mark 14:32-41

“Sit here until I have prayed.”

- Why do you believe Jesus asked them to join Him in His garden experience?

- What is your personal response to someone who asks you for your support during the time of a severe crisis?

“Remove this cup from me; nevertheless, not my will, but what you will.”

Reflection and Prayer

The invitation of Jesus to His disciples to join Him during the most difficult time in His life is significant. In light of what the whole world is facing as the result of Covid19 consider the following things to focus your prayer on:

1. The loss of the lives of loved ones due to the virus, especially those who did not know Jesus.
2. Relief from the financial hardship upon people and families during this national shut down.
3. Encouragement for believers to seek out opportunities to serve and give sacrificially to those in need.
