Revelations 3: 1 - 6 (Sardis The Dead Church)

Review: Thyatira

- Strengths: Works, Love, Faith and Service / Patient endurance and constant improvement.
- Fault or Rebuke: They tolerated pagan practices, justified teaching that led to idolatry.
- The promise: Thyatira will receive authority over the nations and will receive the morning star (Jesus Christ = Rev. 22: 16) Also they will take part in the new heavens and the new earth.
- If you adhere to the doctrine of the timeline of the Christian church throughout its lifespan and history. (Thyatira: covers the time from approximately AD538 AD1798)

Text V1 Read.

"These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars."

- Rev. 1:20 We are told the seven stars are the seven messengers of the churches, then in Rev. 2:1 we are told God / Jesus holds the seven stars in His hand.
- What are the seven Spirits of God?
- **This is the Holy Spirit,** not seven different Spirits... because there is only one H.S.
- > Seven attributes of the H.S. or manifestations of the Spirit.

Isaiah 11: 1 – 2...

"There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots. The <mark>Spirit of the Lord</mark> shall rest on Him, the <mark>Spirit of wisdom</mark> and <mark>understanding</mark>, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of Knowledge and the fear of the Lord."

V1... "You have a name that you are alive, but you are dead."

ESV "I know your works. You have the reputation of being alive, but you are dead."

Sardis: Located on an important highway, a center of commerce, manufacture of carpets and woolen goods, was a source for almost pure gold and silver coins... had a large temple of Artimis a pagan god, also had a large synagogue and a 5-acre gymnasium complex.

Text V's 2 – 3 Read.

Be watchful... Greek, gregoroeō: Lit. means wake up!

ESV *"Wake up, and strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have not found your works complete in the sight of God."*

> V3... "Remember... how you received and heard. Hold fast and repent."

ESV "Remember, then what you received and heard. Keep it, and repent."

Text V4 Read.

- We do have some good news... There are few who have not defiled or compromised themselves.
- They shall walk with Jesus and be clothed in white... "For they are worthy."

Ecclesiastes 9: 7 – 8

"Go, eat your bread with joy, and drink your wine with a merry heart; for God has already accepted your works. Let your garments always be white and let your head lack no oil."

Isaiah 61: 10a

"I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for He has clothed me with garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness..." Text V's 5 – 6 Read.

"He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments."

Revelation 7: 13 – 15... Read.

Malachi 3: 16 -17 "Those who feared the Lord spoke to one another, and the Lord listened and heard them; so, a book remembrance was written before Him for those who fear the Lord and who meditate on His name. They shall be mine, says the Lord of host, on that day I will make them My jewels (Lit. special treasure) and I will spare them as a man spares his own son who serves him..."

Matthew 10: 32 – 33 Read.

"Therefore, whoever confesses me before men, him I will also confess before my Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven."
