1st Peter 4:7-19 (Serving for God's glory and suffering for God's glory)

Review: 1st Peter 4:1-7 (NKJV)

- My revelation: "As it was in the days of Noah..."
- I knew exactly what that meant... I thought, I need to study this out...

Matthew 24:1-14... 34-39, 44

So why does Peter reference Noah when talking about Christ's resurrection and His descent into hell or prison to preach to the spirits in prison...?

We have been living in the last days since the day of Pentecost and the Ascension.

So, what is Peter trying to covey by referencing Noah...?

- Jesus' ascension: ushered in the last days!!
- I believe that Peter is remembering what Jesus told them as recorded in Matthew 24
- The last days will be as they were in the days of Noah.

Tonight: Text 1st Peter 4:7-11 (NKJV) Read

- > V7 "The end of all things is at hand... be serious and watchful in your prayers,"
- > V8 "Have fervent love for one another."

Fervent: Intense passion, zeal, or earnestness, particularly in relation to spiritual devotion and prayer.

James 5:16 "Confess your trespasses to one another, that you may be healed. The effective fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much." (NKJV)

- Now let's read that scripture in context: James 5:13-16... Read (NKJV)
- Love and prayer are to be done fervently! (With passion...)
- Question why love fervently...?

V8 (NASB) "Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins."

- We all sin, we all do and say things we regret. True love forgives (covers) all sin
- Love holds no grudges...

Remember James 5:15 "The prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven."

As Jesus said: "Which is easier to say... thy sins be forgiven or take up your bed and walk" (Healing and forgiveness go hand and hand)

- V's 9 10 (NASB) "Be hospitable to one another without complaint. As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold Grace of God."
- > V11 Read... Oracles of God: utterances of God.
- > "Let him do it with the ability which God supplies." (You must be confident in God's gift... each one of us, God has gifted) It's not your genius or hard work it's God's grace!

Text 1st Peter 4: 12-19 (NKJV) Read

- Beloved, think it not strange... But rejoice... that you are counted worthy to partake of Christ sufferings. (there's that word again... suffering)
- V14... "If you are reproached (Insulted or reviled) for the name of Christ... *Blessed, are* you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rest upon you."
- V17... "For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God."

V18 (NASB) All in caps

"IF IT IS WITH DIFFICUTY THAT THE RIGHTEOUS IS SAVED, WHAT WILL BECOME OF THE GODLESS MAN AND THE SINNER?"

V19 (NKJV) "Therefore let those who suffer according to the will of God commit their souls to Him in doing good, as to a faithful Creator."

(ESV) "Therefore let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good."
